Rock Hill Council of Neighborhoods Web Site

We also have the option of creating our own web site just for our neighborhood. If we want to pursue that, we'll need to discuss it at our meetings.

New Projects for the Coming Year

Garbage Collection Requirements from the City

Everyone in East Town should have the new model of the rollout garbage containers by now. If you don't, call Public Works at 329-5600 and request one. Please remember and observe the following:

- Store all garbage and small trash in your 90-gallon rollcart container. Your rollcart must be stored in the rear of your property and should be kept closed to keep out water and neighborhood pets, and to comply with the Sanitation Ordinance.
- By 7:00 a.m. on your regular collection day (Mondays for ETNA residents), place your rollcart and curbie at the curb in front of your residence. Do not place them in the street. They will be emptied and placed back at the curb.
- Rollcarts and curbies should be moved from the curb to the rear of your residence as soon as it is convenient for you to do so after they have been emptied. All containers should be returned to the back of the residence by 7:00 a.m. on the day after collection (Tuesdays for ETNA residents), as required by City Ordinance.
- Be sure you are recycling everything possible. You may have as many recycle bins as you need, at no cost.
- Crush cartons, detergent boxes and bulky items before placing them in the rollcart.
- Break down corrugated boxes and take them to the nearest City fire station or County drop-off location to recycle them.
- For families who need it, a second rollcart may be purchased from the Public Works Department. There is a \$50 charge for the cart and your sanitation fee will increase by 50 percent.
